

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

### MONROE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MONROE COUNTY, GEORGIA

Sealed Bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the **Old Brent Road Bridge Project** will be received by the Monroe County Board of Commissioners in the Board Room on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of the Monroe County Administration Building at 38 West Main Street, Forsyth, Georgia 31029 until **10:00 A.M.** local time, on Friday, **September 27, 2024**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. All bid questions must be submitted in written form to the Engineer by **5:00 P.M.** on **September 16, 2024**.

The Project consists of removing and disposing of an existing double 96 inch CMP culvert and replacing the double culvert with a precast bridge on the existing alignment of Old Brent Road crossing Todd Creek. The project will also require approximately 550 lineal feet of roadway and bridge approach construction.

The Contract Time is 270 calendar days for this project. Liquidated damages in the amount of \$250.00 shall be assessed for each day the work extends beyond the Contract Time.

The work in the Contract will be awarded on the basis of the total sum bid submitted by the lowest qualified and responsive bidder.

The Instructions to Bidders, Contract Agreement, Specifications and forms of Bid Bond, Performance Bond, and Payment Bond and other Contract Documents may be examined at the office of Carter Engineering Group, 6310 Peake Road, Suite 200, Macon, GA 31210.

A non-refundable fee of \$200.00 will be charged for hard copies. A Contact Name, Company Name, Phone Number, Email Address and Street Address must be provided to ensure a bidder is on the official plan holder list and to receive addenda as issued during the advertisement period. No partial sets of bidding documents shall be issued. Bidders must purchase the Contract Documents from the office of the Engineer in order to be eligible to submit a bid.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, prepared on the form of Bid Bond attached to the Contract Documents, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia and listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount of 10% of the Bid.

The successful Bidder for this Contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the Bid.

All necessary permits for this project are expected to be acquired prior to the commencement of any construction activities.

All anticipated easements and rights-of-way are expected to be acquired prior to commencement of construction activities.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive informalities, and to re-advertise.
